

Health Care Foundation Grant's for CNA Certification and Recertification

Toronto Dominion (TD) Canada Trust is adopting a policy of *investing in people* and has offered the Health Care Foundation a TD Grant in Nursing Skill and Education. These funds will be available to nurses employed with Eastern Health including the five adult hospitals of St. John's: The General Hospital, St. Clare's Mercy Hospital, the Waterford Hospital, the Dr. L.A. Miller Centre, the Dr. Walter Templeman Health Care Centre and Pleasant View Towers. We are excited to inform RN's of this grant which will be available to individuals interested in pursuing the CNA certification or recertification.

- a. Applicants must be (1) permanent employees or (2) temporary / casual employees with a minimum of two years service to Eastern Health.
- b. Applicants must be enrolled in / or accepted to CNA certification / recertification.
- c. Grants will be awarded based on a first come first serve basis.
- d. All successful applicants will agree to have their name released to the Canadian Nurses Association by the Health Care Foundation.
- e. A minimum of one year return of service is required in the specific area of educational preparation.
- f. Funding will be provided upon submission of acceptance documentation to the CNA certification and recertification program (documentation to be submitted to the Health Care Foundation – mail or email hcf@healthcarefoundation.ca)

Application Process

Applications must be submitted to the Health Care Foundation by **March 31, 2018**. Late or incomplete submissions will not be considered.

- a. Applications for the grants must be submitted on the application form available through the Health Care Foundation.
- b. Applications must be accompanied by a letter to the *Grant Selection Committee*.
- c. Approval of grants will be issued by **April 13th, 2018**
- d. Funds will be dispersed upon submission of acceptance documentation to the CNA certification or recertification program.
- e. The decision of the *Grant Selection Committee* will be final and confidential. If the recipient of the grant is unable to complete the program for which the funding was granted, the committee reserves the right to terminate payment or require repayment of the grant monies.
